- North Brisbane Junior Cup is an inter-club fixture competition for junior players. Teams from Ferny Hills Tennis Centre, The Gap Health & Racquet Club, Woods Tennis Centre & Everton Tennis & Gear all compete to win the North Brisbane Junior Cup each season.
- **NEW Format** - 2 player teams: 1 singles & 1 doubles per player.
  - **Division 11 & 7** matches are played on Saturdays from **10.30am – 12.15pm**
  - **Division 9 & 5** matches are played on Saturdays from **12.15 - 2pm.**
- Registration Fee: \$77/player (includes \$27 Tennis Qld Registration)
- Weekly Playing Fee: \$11
- Individual and Team Registrations accepted
- Registrations accepted with full payment of Registration Fee only

# NORTH BRISBANE JUNIOR CUP Season 1 2009

## Conditions of Acceptance

1. All players will be responsible for the maintenance and attendance of their team. If there is a forfeit on any occasion, for any reason whatsoever, then severally or together the team will be liable for the payment of court charges. No individual or team points will be awarded while this amount remains unpaid. To avoid penalties, players are not to assume play is abandoned before consulting the centre where their match is scheduled to be played.
2. All players will wear correct tennis attire or their respective club's designated attire including shirt during all matches.
3. All other rules and regulations as specified in the Rules of the North Brisbane Junior Cup below will be strictly enforced at all times.
4. All players will present themselves in their best manner at all times, completely aware of their obligations.
5. Registration Forms will **NOT** be accepted unless all the details are complete WITH the appropriate registration fees.

## Rules of the North Brisbane Junior Cup

1. Non financial players are not permitted to play more than 4 fill-in matches.
2. All players must pay a team registration fee prior to the proposed deadline to register their team.
3. The centre supervisor reserves the right to cancel or penalise points against any team, player or supporter that:
  - a. Displays unsportsmanlike behaviour
  - b. Plays a fill-in player from a higher division
  - c. Disrupts general play
4. Cancellation of matches due to bad weather:
  - a. The decision to cancel matches in such cases shall be made by the Tennis Centre Manager where the match is being played.
  - b. In the event of rain interrupting play during or before a match, players should make every effort to dry the court in order to continue or commence play. If the court remains unplayable for longer than 40 minutes, the match may be abandoned by either team captain after duly notifying the captain of the opposition team. Players are not obliged to play on courts where the conditions are judged by either captain to be unsafe due to water.
  - c. If both captains agree to play in wet conditions, the Tennis Centre owner/manager has the ultimate authority to refuse play, if playing conditions are deemed unsafe.
  - d. Tennis Centre owner/manager/supervisor must be informed of any such decisions.
5. **Wet Matches** = If an entire Centre is rained out, NO forfeit fee is payable to rained-out Centre and ALL matches shall receive wet points, even when a team has forfeited prior. Where a match is washed out and deemed a match (i.e. after 2 completed sets), teams will receive the higher of either average points or points for wet match. If the wet match occurs during first round (i.e. less than 7 matches for 8 team draw) then the points will be awarded at the end of the first round when averages are calculated. After the first round any rain-shortened matches will have averages calculated up to and including the completed match prior to the rain-shortened match.
6. A 9-point tiebreak will be played at 5 games all. First player to win 5 points.
7. Long then short deuces apply for all sets.
8. Players will change ends at the end of every odd game.
9. Play must commence within 15 minutes of the start time or the 1<sup>st</sup> set will be forfeited. Every 5 minutes that lapse from the 1<sup>st</sup> forfeit time will result in subsequent forfeits of following sets.
10. Matches will consist of 1 set of tennis with the winner being the 1<sup>st</sup> to 6 games.
11. Team points will be awarded as follows:
  - a. 1.0 point for each set won
  - b. 0.1 points for each game won
  - c. 2.5 points for wet/bye match
  - d. 4.8 points for a forfeit win
  - e. 0 points for a forfeit loss
12. Fill-in players may only be used from a lower or equal division.
13. Any rulings that need to be made that are outside the North Brisbane Junior Cup rules will be based on the Tennis Brisbane Saturday Super League rules. These can be found at <http://tennisbrisbane.com.au/images//drafrules.pdf>
